

What is E Invoicing?

- Term "E Invoicing" is incorrect
- E Invoice does not mean raising invoice from GSTN Portal but only means getting a Reference Number from Invoice Portal
- Mandatory for tax payers having turnover exceeding Rs 50 Crores
 - To be made mandatory for tax payers having turnover exceeding Rs 20 Crores from April 1, 2022
- Risk of not generating E Invoice
 - Supplier liable to general penalty
 - Supplier will not be able to generate E Way Bill using the E Way Bill Portal
 - Credit denial in the hands of the recipient
- Action Steps
 - Check on E Invoice portal if any vendor E Invoicing Status states "enabled"
 - Collect a declaration from vendor that their turnover does not exceed Rs 20 Crores
 - Include the aforementioned declaration in the Purchase Order / Work Orders



- 3. A business having turnover of Rs 20 Crore. Should they raise E Invoice on supplies to SEZ Unit?




Transaction Flow



IRP and IRN


- Unique 64 Digit Alphanumeric Series
 - 453c0d4d154f295a808299dc84ab31dffef87a47b70d23602caea41133287ee4
- IRP Run by NIC
 - Holds data for 24 Hours
 - Checks for duplication of invoices
 - Invoice Cancellation within 24 Hours unless active E Way Bill available
 - Helps in verifying the invoice
- QR Code
 - Machine Readable
 - Contains few fields of the invoice



Generating an E Invoice


Step 1 – Download Bulk Generation Utility (https://einvoice1-trial.nic.in/Others/BulkGenerationTools)



- Step 2 Fill in the mandatory details in the utility like Invoice No., Value, GST etc
 - Validate To check the errors
 - Prepare JSON For converting data into JSON

Generating an E Invoice

○ Step 3 – Login to the E Invoice Trial Portal and click on E-Invoice>Bulk Upload



Step 4 – Upload the JSON file created at Step 2


